Ashippun Town Board Minutes from Budget Public Hearing <u>11/16/06</u>

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Schoenike at 7:00 p.m. Pledge to the flag was given. Those in attendance were Chairman Schoenike, Supervisors Guckenberger and Kopfer and Clerk Schlieve and 6 town residents. Chairman Schoenike explained that this is a public meeting and comments and discussion is welcome. Supervisor Guckenberger explained each line item as presented in the proposed 2007 budget. The budget increase was held to 4.628% to correspond with our net new construction applied to the 2005 tax levy. Spending will be up 4.78% and the levy will be \$465,419.00. The mill rate will be down \$.005 to \$2.328 per \$1,000.

There was much discussion on the Oconomowoc Fire Departments billings to the Town of Ashippun for ambulance services, the Ashippun Fire Department budget, the Roosevelt Road reconstruction and retaining the remaining property for that roadwork.

Syl Hoerth moved to adopt the 2006 Town Tax Levy to be paid in 2007. Jim Schlieve seconded the motion. All but one voted in favor of adopting the Levy. Motion carried.

Larry Krier moved to approve the total 2007 Highway Expenditures on the 2007 Budget. Syl Hoerth seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Seeing no additional comments or discussion, the public hearing was closed at 8:20 p.m.

Supervisor Guckenberger moved to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Kopfer seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.
